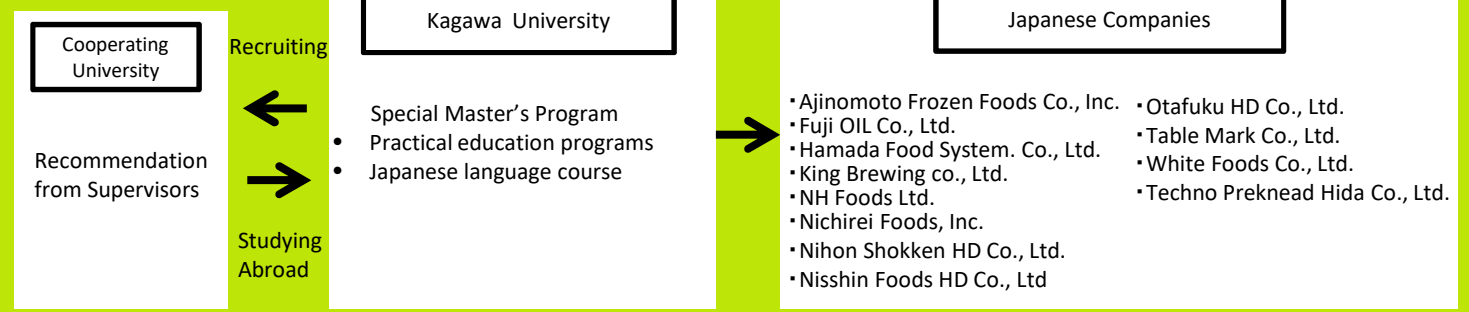
Special Master's Program on Sustainable Food Production and Management

Program Goals

This course aims to contribute to developing human resources in Asia by fostering highly specialized human resources who will serve as a bridge between Japan and Asia. We will develop human resources to improve environmentally friendly agricultural technologies in Asia and to promote high-quality, safe agricultural products and food products.

Program System



Schedule

Stage 1: Initial Application

Applicants must submit initial applications.

September 19, 2023 - January 4, 2024

Stage 2: Interview

Applicants will be interviewed, in person or via teleconferencing, by the Admissions Committee of the Special Master's Program on Sustainable Food Production and Management.

January 5, 2023 - January 15, 2023

Stage 3: Submission of Application Documents

The required documentation must be received by February 29, 2024. Late applications will not be considered for admission.

February 7, 2024 - February 29, 2024

Stage 4: Discussion of Research Plan

Applicants must discuss their proposed research with a prospective faculty advisor.

By February 29, 2024

Stage 5: Offer of Admission

The Admission Committee of the Special Master's Program on Sustainable Food Production and Management will make an official offer of Admission to the successful applicants.

March 6, 2024

Admission Requirements

Candidates must communicate in English well and learn Japanese before coming to Japan. A level of Japanese language proficiency corresponding to the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT N4) or higher is required. For the English language, corresponding to CEFR B1 or higher is required.
