

Vacancy for PhD Professor - Department of Nutrition of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo

The Dean of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo (FSP-USP) announces the opening call for the faculty position in Full-Time Dedication to Teaching and Research (RDIDP in the Portuguese acronym), fields of Institutional Food Services, Culinary and Food Systems.

A professor with a PhD in Sciences, Nutrition, Health Sciences or Public Health is expected for this vacancy, which embraces the fields of Institutional Food Services, Culinary and Food Systems. Emphatically, there is a need for a professor with professional and academic experience, and, therefore, with expertise and identification with the areas of institution food service, culinary and/or gastronomy. This professor must contribute with current knowledge, but also offer dialogue with aspects related to the planning and management of menus for different communities, programs and public equipments of Food and Nutritional Security, culinary indicators related to the provision of foodstuffs and planning of purchases, sustainability applied to food services, good hygiene and food handling practices (quality control) with an emphasis on management of institutional food services and the production of meals with an emphasis on hospital gastronomy. They should also master cooking procedures and techniques in line with the recommendations of the Food Guide for the Brazilian Population, the Food Guide for Brazilian Children Under 2 years of age and the best evidence on healthy and sustainable diets. It is also considered that nutritionist training requires transversal skills and competences such as ethics, management skills, communication, and interface with the National Food and Nutrition Policy and Food and Nutrition Education. Thus, this teacher must be able to contextualize such skills and competencies in the area of Institutional Food Service.

Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D granted or recognized by USP. Applications will be accepted between January 10th, 2023, at 09:00 a.m. to April 10th 2023, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 13,357.25 plus benefits. The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

1. Principles and fundamentals of food security, sovereignty and culture, health promotion and the human right to adequate food in the production of meals;
2. Importance of culinary skills to promote healthy and sustainable food systems;

3. Management and practices aimed at producing meals and promoting health in the Worker's Food Program;
4. Management and practices aimed at producing meals and promoting health in the National School Feeding Program;
5. Management and planning of public facilities for food and nutritional security (such as popular restaurants and food banks);
6. Culinary skills applied to planning menus for the community (schools, prisons, long-term institutions, among others);
7. Dimensioning of area, equipment and human resources in institutional food service units;
8. Elaboration of recipes and fact sheets appropriate to food, nutritional, socio-cultural and economic needs, as a planning and management tool in institutional food service;
9. Costs, revenues, provisioning, inventory control and purchase of foodstuffs in institutional food service units;
10. Food waste and leftovers in institutional food services: prevention and control;
11. Culinary skills and culinary and gastronomic techniques for producing meals, in line with the recommendations of the Food Guide for the Brazilian Population;
12. Institutional food service in the context of healthy and sustainable food systems;
13. Planning, menu engineering and menu management and sustainability in food and nutrition units.

The entire application process - from the inscription to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of impersonality, as well as by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the FSP.
