

Vacancy for PhD Professor - Department of Nutrition of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo

The Dean of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo (FSP-USP) announces the opening call for the faculty position in Complete Shift System (RTC in the Portuguese acronym), field of Clinical Nutrition.

The department expects a professor with full knowledge in Clinical Nutrition and practical experience in hospitals, outpatient clinics or offices is expected, preferably within the scope of the Unified Health System of Brazil. Hiring a professor with this profile will provide a professional able to enrich the two disciplines of Clinical Nutrition and to reinforce the applied nature of the contents related to the Clinical Nutrition in the different spaces of care production in the healthcare network (such as hospitals, clinics and basic health units), enriching the possibilities of practices with student participation. This faculty member will also be able to boost the current interface between the School of Public Health and internship locations in Clinical Nutrition, such as the University Hospital and the Paula Souza School Health Center. He/she will also be able to contribute to enable the preceptorship activities of nutritionist residents linked to the Multidisciplinary Residency in Public Health and Primary Care of the Department of Preventive Medicine, of which our school is a partner.

Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D granted or recognized by USP. Applications will be accepted between January 10th, 2023, at 09:00 a.m. to April 10th 2023, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 5.877,28 plus benefits. The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

1. Organization of food and nutritional care in the health care network of the Unified Health System;
2. Nutritional assessment in different areas of clinical nutrition;
3. Enteral and parenteral nutritional therapy in specialized hospital and home care;
4. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with malnutrition and sarcopenia;
5. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with diseases of the digestive system;

6. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with obesity;
7. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people living with HIV and AIDS;
8. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with kidney diseases;
9. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with cardiovascular diseases;
10. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with cancer;
11. Pathophysiological mechanisms, diet therapy and interprofessional approach in the care of people with diabetes mellitus;
12. Food and nutritional care in palliative care;
13. Expanded understanding of food and nutrition care in the clinical setting and gender and ethnic-racial inequalities.

The entire application process - from the inscription to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of impersonality, as well as by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the FSP.
