Briefly, the position requires a commitment to teaching and extension activities and the ability to conduct independent research. Interested applicants should hold a PhD granted or recognized by USP. Applications will be accepted between February 8th, 2023, at 09:00 a.m. to May 9th 2023, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary is R\$ 13,357.25 plus benefits (level MS3).

The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

- 3. Disciplinary fields and central concepts for studies on aging and health
- 4. Institutionalization of the life course and aging
- 5. The challenges of the intersectional approach for a broad conception of the processes of aging in the field of Public Health
- 6. Healthy aging, euthanasia, dignified death: normativities about the end of life
- 7. Gender, race/ethnicity, aging and health
- 8. Intergenerational dynamics, the experience of aging and health
- 9. Gender and sexuality in aging: discussions for the health field
- 10. Medicalization, overdiagnosis, overtreatment and quaternary prevention in old age
- 11. Class, territory and aging: issues for policies of social protection
- 12. Aging and global burden of diseases
- 13. Reorientation of public policies in face of inequalities and populational aging
- 14. The decade of healthy aging and public policies in Brazil

The entire application process - from the inscription to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of impersonality, as well as by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the FSP.
