

Vacancy for PhD Professor - Department of Environmental Health of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo

The Dean of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo (FSP-USP) announces the opening call for the faculty position (full-time), specialty **Worker's health**.

Briefly, the position requires a commitment to teaching and extension activities and the ability to conduct independent research. Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D granted or recognized by USP. Applications will be accepted between March 20th, 2023, at 09:00 a.m. to June 18th 2023, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 13,357.25 plus benefits. The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

- 01) Public Health and worker's health: concepts, interfaces and policies;
- 02) Environmental sustainability and workers' health: interfaces and policies;
- 03) From occupational health to decent work: historical evolution in Brazil – advances, setbacks and possible paths;
- 04) The National Policy of Workers Health and the National Network for Integral Workers Health Care (RENAST, acronym in portuguese) as health promoters;
- 05) Relationships amongst work, health and environment: the role of the social and the environmental determinants of health;
- 06) Surveillance and intervention models in workers' health;
- 07) Public policies for adapting or for mitigating climate change in working conditions and workers' health: paths to decent work and sustainability;
- 08) Formative intervention, and methodological contributions from the Laboratory of Change, and other modalities of participatory research-intervention for workers' health and safety;
- 09) Ergonomics in the production of safety, health and work results;
- 10) Impact of global crises – climate, environmental degradation, economic and social – on working conditions and worker health;
- 11) Social inequalities, informality, working conditions and workers' health;
- 12) Premature functional aging and factors associated with workers' health: assessment, damage prevention and social security.

The entire application process - from the inscription to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of impersonality, as well as by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the FSP.
