

Vacancy for Ph.D. Professor - Department of Environmental Health of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo

The Dean of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo (FSP-USP) announces the opening call for the faculty position (full-time), specialty on Climate and Environmental Health.

Briefly, the position requires a commitment to teaching and extension activities and the ability to conduct independent research. The candidate profile desired is experience in teaching, participation and collaboration in national and international research projects concerning the knowledge of the indicated topics. Interested applicants must hold a Ph.D. granted or recognized by USP.

Applications will be accepted between April 19th, 2024, at 09:00 a.m. to July 18th, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 14.761,02 plus benefits. The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

1. Climate rhythm and climate change: what are the differences in terms of human health?
2. Climate elements and geographic scales: bases for research.
3. The interfaces of atmospheric pollution and climate change.
4. Interventions and public policies to mitigate and adapt to extreme impacts of climate change on health.
5. The impacts of climate change on emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases.
6. The impacts of climate change on non-communicable diseases.
7. Instruments, methods, and techniques for climate studies and its relationship with human health.
8. Bioclimatology and sanitation.
9. Climate and health vulnerability in areas of precarious urbanization.
10. Nature-based solutions to face climate change.
11. Water governance and climate extremes: scarcity and abundance
12. Climate change in the southern cone and tropical diseases

The entire application process - from the application to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably the rule of impersonality, and by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the School of Public Health.
